### Apple Walnut Cake Serves 12-15

1 (20 oz.) can Apple Pie Filling

2 cup flour

1 cup sugar

1½ tsp. Soda

1 tsp. salt

2 eggs beaten

1 tsp. vanilla

2/3 cup cooking oil

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup chopped walnuts

Preheat oven to 350. Spread pie filling in bottom of 9"x13" pan.

Combine flour, sugar, soda and salt sprinkle over filling. In bowl combine eggs, vanilla, oil and  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of nuts, mix well. Pour over ingredients in pan. Stir only until blended. Smooth batter evenly

in pan. Bake at 350 for 40-45 min. until cake springs back from light touch. Cool on rack about 20 min. Prick warm cake with fork.

### Topping

1 cup sugar

 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup sour cream

½ tsp. Soda

Combine sugar, sour cream and soda, stir over medium heat until

boiling. Pour topping over cake and sprinkle with remaining nuts.
