- 1. Meeting called to order by President, Diane Cerny.
- 2. Those in attendance introduced themselves and shared where they lived and on what machine they quilted. Members signed a card of encouragement for Michelle Lynch.
- 3. Previous minutes:

4. Treasurer report:

5. Committee reports:

a. Same But Different: Discussion-quilts could not be displayed in the Edmond Guild Show because of space constraints. They will be stored by Diane Cerny and discussion will continue concerning using them in booth space rented in a future show to promote our association, OKMQA.

b. Newsletter-Audrey asked submissions to be made as soon as possible for this quarter's newsletter.

c. Membership-Annette Bean reported that we have 23 current members. Dues (\$15) are now being accepted for the 2023 year.

d. Positive Tomorrows: Joyce Curtis gave a description of what Positive Tomorrow Quilts are and the students to whom they are presented. She shared a sample top and gave a brief description of how the kit prep, piecing, quilting, and binding process works. She has a group that also provides batting when needed. She presented 90 quilts to Positive Tomorrows in September, one per enrolled student at the time.




