- 1. Meeting called to order by President, Diane Cerny.
- 2. Printed copy of April 9, 2022 minutes provided to members.
 - Joyce Curtis moved to approve the minutes as written.
 - Rita Torneten seconded the motion.
 - Motion was approved by member vote.
- 3. Treasurer's Report was given by Diane Cerny (as provided by Colleen Billen)
 - a. 2022 income and expense report: Balance as of 7/23/2022 \$2,941.99
 - Leah Alspaugh moved to approve the Treasurer's Report.
 - Mary Marlatt seconded the motion.
 - Motion was approved by member vote.
 - b. 2022 proposed budget:
 - Vonnie Merritt moved to accept the budget as presented.
 - Mary Marlatt seconded the motion.
 - Motion was approved by member vote.
- 4. Committee Reports:
 - a. Same But Different: Mary Marlatt returned quilts displayed in May at the Norman Quilt Show for potential display at the Edmond Quilt Meeting (August 12-13, 2022).

- b. Audrey Gramling asked for newsletter items to be emailed to her as soon as possible as she will be traveling and wants to get this action complete.
- c. Membership: Currently, 21 paid members.
- d. Positive Tomorrows: Joyce Curtis reported she has enough quilts prepared for delivery this Fall 2022, however she does have many tops (over 150!) ready for quilting. Joyce provides the top, batting, backing and binding for as many (or few) quilts as you can handle. She also indicated that if you prefer to only do the machine quilting, you can return to her and she has others who volunteer to complete the binding.
- e. Library: As approved in April's meeting, the remaining content of our Library was made available to all members (free!) at the meeting for their personal use. Rita is preparing a list of remaining items (DVDs only) and will reach out to other area Guilds to see if they would be interested in a donation.
- 5. Old Business:
 - a. Diane Cerny reported on upcoming meeting program for October: Trish Maxwell (owner/operator of Journey Quilts) will prepare a "Tips & Tricks" related to running a quilting business.
- 6. New Business:
 - a. How to increase membership numbers: Current efforts have included bookmark flyer notes distributed to area quilt shops, as well as postings to Facebook and other quilt-related sites. Members were encouraged to bring a friend to our next meeting.
 - b. Marketing/Promotion of our Group: Mary Marlatt suggested posting brief videos (2-3 minutes) from our programs/presentations to give prospective visitors an idea of what they can expect if they attend.
