OKMQA Minutes of January 14, 2023

- 1. Meeting called to order by President, Diane Cerny.
- 2. Those in attendance introduced themselves and shared on what machine they quilted.
- 3. Minutes from the October 29, 2022 meeting were presented in printed form for the members. Joyce Curtis moved to approve the minutes as written, Colleen Billen seconded the motion, and the motion was approved by member vote.
- 4. Treasurer's report was presented in printed form to the members with a proposed 2023 budget attached. Discussion of the 2023 budget centered on the advertising, program, and activity allowances. After discussion, a motion was made by Michelle Lynch to accept the report as written with an amendment to the proposed budget adding \$200 in an activity fund. Vonnie Meritt seconded the motion and it was approved by member vote.
- 5. Committee reports:

- c. *Membership*-Annette Bean reported that we have 12 new or renewing members as of this month, bringing our current membership to 20.
- d. *Positive Tomorrows*-Joyce Curtis asked for quilters for quilts. She brought a dozen to try and find someone to quilt. She has people who will piece and bind but needs quilts quilted.
- e. *Library*-last items from the library were available for anyone to take today before disposal.
- f. *Activities*-Diane Cerny proposed a 2023 Mystery Project. The project will provide instructions at January, April, and July meetings, with the final project due and prizes awarded at the October meeting.

POTATO CHIP BLOCK

During Show & Share Michelle Lynch showed several quilts she had made with "potato chip blocks". Several of us loved what she did with these scrappy blocks and so for your piecing enjoyment here is Michelle's pattern: Cut bricks 2 ½" x 4 ½". Michelle used 32 bricks in a block. You can make any size blocks to utilize the scraps that you have. Make sure your pieces are twice as long as they are wide. Michelle suggested a YouTube video "Conquering Mount Scrapmore with Brenda".
