January 19th OMQA Guild Meeting Minutes

Guest/New Members: Four new members and one guest attended the meeting.

The minutes from the previous meeting were not available.

Programs: The program was on binding a quilt on a domestic sewing machine and was provided by Beth Soward.

Newsletter: Per Al a newsletter would be coming out before the January meeting.

Librarian: A \$25 deposit is required to check an item from the library and you can keep it until the next meeting.

It was suggested as a fund raiser to sell OKMQA pins.
