Today, the Sooner or Later Challenge category closed, and no submissions will be accepted after July 25th. Those who submit a response to the "Quilt Writing" last challenge, at the October meeting, will have their names added to the drawing.

During the October meeting, the final drawing will be held for those who participated in the Activity challenges over the past two years. The drawings will begin with the Prompt Responders for the first three prizes. Then the Sooner or Laters will be added to drawing and names drawn until all prizes have been awarded. As of July 25th there were 34 Prompt Responders and Nine Sooner or Laters.
